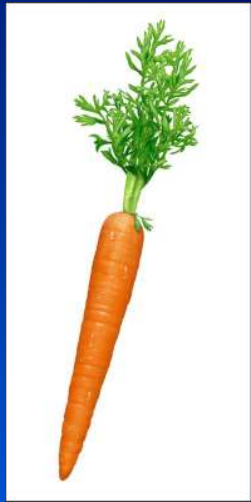
We celebrate Christmas on the 25th of December
