

Christmas In England



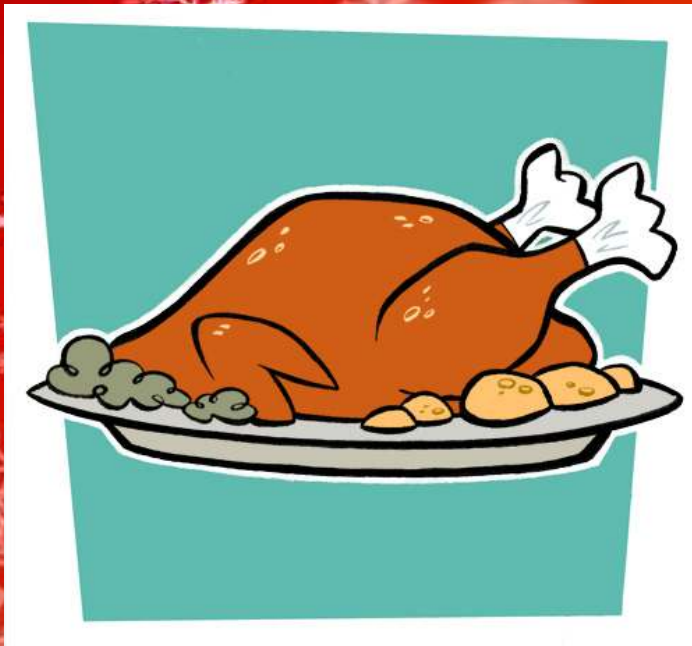
In England we put our presents
